Paywall: The Business of Scholarship is a documentary film, launched on 5 September 2018 in Washington D.C, which focuses on the need for open access to research and science. It questions the rationale behind the \$25.2 billion a year that flows into for-profit academic publishers, examines the 35-40% profit margin associated with the top academic publisher Elsevier and looks at how that profit margin is often greater than some of the most profitable tech companies like Apple, Facebook and Google.

The world of academic publishing is all about credibility, and most scholars want to be published in the nation's most reputable academic journals. But accessing those journals can be very expensive. While large universities can often afford to foot the bill, researchers at smaller colleges, or those in developing countries, may find themselves unable to afford access to the latest scientific research.
