Ballangé examines three founding currents in the political integration of the EU: French planist genealogy, Italian federalist genealogy and German ordoliberal genealogy. She examines how each of these genealogies positioned itself vis-àvis democracy, and seeks to answer how these positions affected the inclusion of Europe's peoples in the integration process.
